The Novice Young Standard females produced the only Novice 1st ribbon of the day for Michelle Williams with good size & conformation but slightly open fur.

There were nine Young females, split into two colour Medium colour phase produced Crutchley's with good size, coverage and fur quality going Reserve Best Young Female. colour phase also gave the first, which became Best Standard Female.

The Novice Young Standard Males produced a 2nd & 3rd for Trevor Pugsley, who is obviously moving in the right direction, and a HC for Wendy French.

Fifteen Young Standard males were split into three colour phases. The Dark colour phase produced a 1st ribbon and Best Young Standard for Aileen Cooke & David Blakey having good size, conformation fur & coverage but spoilt by a tinge to the fur.

The Medium-Darks also produced a 1st ribbon with good size & conformation but let down again by poor clarity.

Another 1st in the Medium phase for the Crutchley's with a chinchilla with good size & conformation but out of condition on the day, lacking eye appeal.

Just one Novice Adult Female ribbon winner, an HC for Wendy French.

Just six Adult Standard Females in the main show classes produced the Best Standard of the day from the Crutchley's with good size, conformation and fur quality, which went on to take Show Champion.

There were no awards in the Novice Adult Standard Males.

Again just one colour phase for the seven Adult Standard Males in the main show classes produced another 1st for the Crutchley's with good size, conformation, fur & coverage, although a little out of condition, went on to take Reserve Show Champion.

The Novice Young Mutations produced a 2nd for Eunice Poon with her Self Black and a 2nd for Wenda Barron with her Beige.

The main Young Mutations produced a 1st ribbon Black Velvet for the Crutchley's with good size, conformation and coverage but out of show condition going on to take Reserve Best Mutation and a 1st ribbon Pink White, good size, conformation, fur strength but slightly down in clarity going on to take Best Mutation.

Just one ribbon winner in the Novice Adult Mutations a HC for Louise Punchard for her Self Brown.

Disappointingly there were no 1st ribbon winners in the main Adult Mutations.
