I arrived at Biggar around damp 3 hour trip. A slight due to a mix up over the hall me chance to have a couple of which prepared me for this

Fourteen Young Standard split into two colour phases, Medium-Darks producing a 1st David Blakey & Aileen Cook.

good size, conformation and clarity, with good dense fur, but was out of condition on the sides but good enough to go on to take Reserve Best Young Standard Female. Second to this in the Medium-Darks was an animal from Wendy French which although was a bit small, had good conformation, good clarity and fur type, though was out of condition.

Six animals in the Medium colour phase produced a 1st ribbon for Julie Turner, having good size and conformation, loads of fur, reasonable clarity and going on to take Best Young Standard Female and Reserve Best Young Standard.

The Young Standard Males were again split into two colour phases, with the Mediums producing just two HC's.

The Medium-Darks produced a 1st for Robert Allen with good size and conformation, good fur type, and good density and clarity, going on to take Best Young Standard Male and Best Young Standard.

In the Novice Young Standard Males, Michelle Williams exhibited a 1st ribbon winning animal having good size and conformation, plenty of eye appeal, good clarity, but open fur, although lots of potential for improvement with age, going on to take Reserve Best Young Standard Male.

Five Adult Females produced a 1st for James Buchan for a chin with good size and conformation, OK clarity, and good fur type, going on to take Best Adult Standard Female, Res Best Adult Standard, and Reserve Best Standard Animal.

Eight Adult Males produced another 1st for James, for a chin of good size but I didn't like the conformation much, having a slight dip in neck and hunched back - a very bright animal but out of condition, going on to take Best Adult Standard Male and Reserve Adult Standard.

A good class of Novice Adult Standard Males followed and another 1st for Michelle Williams for her chin of excellent size and conformation, loads of dense fur, out of condition but a very high quality animal, going on to take Best Standard In Show and Reserve Show Champion, a 2nd ribbon to this was shown by Lisa Barron which had good size and conformation, was out of condition but had excellent veiling and density.

In the Young Mutations the young Black Velvets produced yet another 1st for James Buchan, good size and conformation, excellent fur type, excellent coverage, breaking just slightly but what potential for the future, going on to take Best Mutation and Show Champion! The only other notable animal in the Young Mutations, a 1st ribbon Violet from Wenda Barron was of good size and conformation, good clarity, open strong fur, being five months old and again with good potential, going on to take Reserve Best Mutation.
