

## **Show Report – WM & SR Show, Bugbrooke, 10<sup>th</sup> Feb 2008**

### **Judge: - Georgie Busher**

I was pleased to be able to judge this joint show. When I arrived the hall was ready and waiting with lights, chairs and tables all in place, as well as a welcome cup of coffee.

I began with one Novice Young Standard Female along with 5 main show Medium colour phase entrants. All the animals were rather small. I gave a 1<sup>st</sup> to a reasonably sized animal with good fur and colour and a very blue white underbelly. A third and two HC's to animals of varying condition with more open fur.

The Novice had a third having good potential but required more attention to the grooming.

There were four Medium-Darks in a class giving a 2<sup>nd</sup> to a small animal with good fur type and colour and a highly commended. Thus the Boncey's Medium became Best Young Standard Female, a nice animal which may well improve.

There was only one Novice Young Standard Male which was judged with the main class. It was quite good but rather narrow - the fur being rough on the flanks, and so I awarded a third. There were three Mediums and five Medium-Darks. Albatross took a 1<sup>st</sup> in the Mediums with a big blocky well furred animal. There were also two HC's for animals which required tighter fur and greater size. The Medium-Darks were a nice class, the 1<sup>st</sup> going to the Boncey's with a good animal having excellent conformation and good colour. The 2<sup>nd</sup> from Albatross had more open fur but was of good size and quality and the 3<sup>rd</sup> from the Boncey's had great potential for one so young.

The Medium-Dark young male took Best Young Standard Male, Best Young Standard And Best Standard Animal awards, with the Medium taking Res. Young Standard Male and Res. Young Standard Animal so congratulations to the Boncey's and Albatross for producing animals in fair show condition in a very difficult season.

There was one Novice Adult Standard Female which I was unable to give an award. Five Medium-Dark Adult Females gave me a 1<sup>st</sup> winner with a very big blocky animal in good condition but just showing a hint of tinge. A third was given to another big blocky animal with nice fur and colour but out of condition and breaking.

Thus the Boncey's took Best Adult Standard Female - they were having a good day.

The Adult Standard Males were disappointing the Novice animal was given a HC, it had reasonable fur quality but was hump backed and narrow. In the main show there was a 2<sup>nd</sup> for another narrow animal, dark with lovely strong silky fur and a third for a big much blockier animal way out of condition with an off colour bar.

The Best Adult Female became Best Adult Standard and was pipped for Best Standard by the Best Young Standard Male. Congratulations to the Boncey's.

There were eight Novice Young Mutations. A class of three Brown Velvets went 1, 2 and 3. The 1<sup>st</sup> was small with dark brown velvet colour, the 2<sup>nd</sup> was a bigger animal but not such a good colour and lacked condition and the 3<sup>rd</sup> had insufficient mutation coverage.

Of the 5 AOC's a reasonable Beige had a third as did a Black velvet which had fair size but was not black enough.

Twenty Young Mutations made 4 full classes plus an AOC. The six Wilson Whites produced a 1<sup>st</sup> for a big clear animal with nice blue standard fur showing through the white. The 2<sup>nd</sup>

was slightly off colour but had good size and conformation. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and HC were also of good quality.

There were three Beiges, the 1<sup>st</sup> having a light clear colour was a big animal with good fur and finish. A 3<sup>rd</sup> was given to a narrower animal with lots of good silky fur but was priming on the day.

Of the three Brown Velvets a 1<sup>st</sup> was given to a very good animal in excellent condition.

Four Black Velvets were headed by a smaller animal with really good black silky fur and coverage and a 2<sup>nd</sup> to a bigger animal that did not have the coverage of the first. An HC went to a promising baby.

In the AOC class The Pink Whites had a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. The winner had very good fur type and had good size and colour whilst the 2<sup>nd</sup> was narrower with less even fur.

A lovely little Violet in prime condition and of good clear blue colour also gained a first. The Violet from Albatross became Best Young Mutation which just beat the Boncey's Brown Velvet which was Reserve.

Thirteen Novice Adult Mutations gave a class of Self-Blacks which produced a very nice animal with blue wrap around fur and fair fur strength and two HC's which out on condition and fur strength over the hips.

A 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> for Emma Ross's Ultra Violets, the first of good colour but small for an adult, whilst the third was down in colour. In AOC there was a 2<sup>nd</sup> for a Sapphire and a Beige, both were of reasonable size and quality but lacked condition.

The Adult Mutations were six in total - a class of Wilson Whites and 2 AOC. A first was awarded for a really big white chin having excellent fur, which was really clear and blue. Another white animal had a HC which did not have the fur strength or colour of the winner.

Both AOC's had firsts, the Gardner's had a lovely Brown Velvet which just needed a touch more mutation fur and Fiona Garnett produced a nice big Beige, well covered with strong fur in excellent condition and good colour. The Wilson White was Best Mutation and the Reserve went to the Beige.

For Best in Show the Standards lost out to the Mutations on condition, so congratulations to Fiona Garnett on an excellent double. Thanks to Stewards, the Kitchen Staff and the Registrars for an enjoyable days judging.
