

## Show Report – Southern Region, Bugbrooke, 30<sup>th</sup> March 08

***97 Entries, 49 Standards (7 Novice) & 48 Mutations (13 Novice)***

I was pleasantly surprised to entry of 97 chins and my an early afternoon finish were With Kerry Bradburn as my day, we split the Young Females into three classes.

The Medium-Dark class had a [Dick and Heather Green] for good size and conformation,

not finished, with soft baby fur on the flanks. A 2<sup>nd</sup> ribbon to Steve and Heather Boncey for a more mature chin but smaller than the 1<sup>st</sup> with a very tight strong fur.

Joyce Garvey had a 2<sup>nd</sup> award in the Medium colour phase for a good type of animal but not bright in clarity of colour.

There was a 1<sup>st</sup> in the Dark class for Steve and Heather that had good finish and veiling that came down over the sides that also became Reserve Best Young Standard Female.

The star of the young females came from Claire Turner's novice entry. This dark colour phase chin had strong silky fur, excellent veiling and a blue clear colour. She not only achieved Best Young Standard Female but also Reserve Best Young Standard.

We were unable to sub-divide the 8 young males, with all judged as Medium-Darks. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> awards went to Eddie and Richard Crutchley. The 1<sup>st</sup> was in excellent condition, not a hair out of place, everything about this young male was very good/excellent with beautiful blue colour, strong fur, good conformation and clear white belly. He progressed right through the show to being awarded Best In Show.

The single novice young male was a reasonable type with bright colour and a chin to work with for Kate Renfrew.

The eleven Adult Standard Females were split into two colour phases. The majority were very much out of condition and the five Mediums only had two Highly Commended ribbons awarded.

The six Medium-Darks had a 1<sup>st</sup> for Steve and Heather that was in reasonable condition, had strong fur and density with good colour, and went forward to be Reserve Best Standard Animal.

Claire Turner had a 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Novice Adult Female class, a chin with good coverage but narrow in the neck.

The ten Adult Standard Males also couldn't be divided by colour phasing and stayed as one class. This was only the start of the problems with this group. We had two males with very good clarity of colour and fur type but quite small for 7 months or over from Eddie and Richard and a very large mature male from Roman and Jane Gesikowski, with excellent conformation, strong dense fur that was very much down in colour. We were unable to award a 1<sup>st</sup> in this group and 2<sup>nd</sup> went to Eddie and Richard's male, with Roman and Jane taking 3<sup>rd</sup> with three HC's also awarded.

After a break for lunch we resumed with a class of three Novice Young Beiges, all from Rosemary Paxman, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> and 2 HC's awarded. All had clear colour but were out of show condition. An AOC class had a 3<sup>rd</sup> for a Brown Velvet also from Rosemary that was down on colour, and a Black Velvet from Claire Turner that needed better coverage.

The main show Young Mutations had five classes with five 1<sup>st</sup> awards.

The four Wilson Whites had a 1<sup>st</sup> for Fiona Garnett for a good type of animal with clear white colour, although with slightly open fur which became Reserve Best Young Mutation.

Three Pink Whites brought a 1<sup>st</sup> for Joyce Garvey for her young male of pleasing almond colour getting the decision over 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> ribbon winners from Steve and Heather which were both well furred.

Three Beiges also had a 1, 2, 3, with Ron and Lyn Gardner having 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the class. The 1<sup>st</sup> was in good condition with paler colour to the 2<sup>nd</sup> darker beige with plushy fur type. Joyce had 3<sup>rd</sup> with her bright but out of condition chin that didn't help itself by doing 'roly-poly' acrobatics .

Five Violets also had 1, 2, 3 with 1<sup>st</sup> to Ron and Lyn with good type and size and that elusive Violet sheen, but not quite as bright as the 2<sup>nd</sup> from Albatross that was small with 3<sup>rd</sup> also from Albatross.

The AOC class had a 1<sup>st</sup> for a Brown Velvet from Steve and Heather which was of good size, strong fur and good coverage, becoming Best Young Mutation. There was a 2<sup>nd</sup> for a Self Black from Lyn and Ron with good colour and coverage but small.

An AOC class of six Novice Adult Mutations had a 2<sup>nd</sup> for a Black Velvet, 3<sup>rd</sup> awards for a Violet and a Wilson White - all from Claire Turner that unfortunately I have no notes on - my apologies Claire.

In the main show Adult Mutations we had four classes and again four 1<sup>st</sup> awards made.

Three Wilson Whites brought only one award, a 1<sup>st</sup> for Sandy King. This chin was of good size, a clear white colour, reasonable fur type that was slightly open furred.

Four Beiges had a 1<sup>st</sup> for Joyce Garvey for her bright coloured chin with strong plushy fur type that became Reserve Adult Mutation and Reserve Best Mutation.

Four Black Velvets with a clear 1<sup>st</sup> for Eddie and Richard Crutchley. This winner was a good blocky chin with clear blue/black intense colour, dense strong fur and good coverage. This chin became not only Best Adult Mutation and Best Mutation in Show but also Reserve Best in Show.

The AOC class had a 1<sup>st</sup> for a Violet from Joyce with good clear colour and a 3<sup>rd</sup> for a Brown Velvet from Ron and Lyn - a good type that had oxidised.

My thanks go to Kerry for ably assisting me on the day. Congratulations to Eddie and Richard for bringing both Best and Reserve Best in Show chins.

Also my thanks to all who brought chins to the show and all that helped in making this another successful day.
