

Show Report – North Region Show, Birdwell, 4th Nov 2007

The twelve Young Standard split into three colour phases, medium/darks produced a 1st Crutchley's with good size, coverage in reasonable show 2nd ribbon to this being slightly reasonable size and condition.

The four darks produced the Crutchley's, this having conformation & clarity, nice and plenty of eye appeal, the

a bit dull in comparison but again good density and good conformation.

Just one ribbon in the Medium colour phase for a 1st with good size and conformation, tight fur with good clarity and unusually going on to take Best Young Standard Female, with the 1st ribbon Dark young female taking Reserve.

Fourteen Young Standard Males were again split into three colour phases, with another 1st for the Crutchley's in the Medium-Darks, which was of good size and conformation, with tight fur but a bit dull.

The Darks produced another 1st, with another good sized animal, of good conformation and condition, the 2nd to this was also of good size and conformation but was priming on the day. The Mediums produced another 1st for another animal of good size, conformation and clarity and strong upright fur.

The 1st ribbon Dark took the Best Young Standard Male award, along with Best Young Standard, Best Standard and eventual Show Champion. The 1st ribbon Medium took Reserve Young Standard Male, Reserve Young Standard, Reserve Standard and Reserve Show Champion.

Six Adult Standard Females in group C were split into two colour phases and produced just one 1st ribbon for the Crutchley's in the Medium-Dark class for a chin with good size and conformation, tight fur but out of show condition. This animal took Best Adult Standard Female award and Reserve Adult Standard. Second in the Medium-Darks went on to take Res Best Adult Female.

Three Adult Standard Males in Group D produced another 1st ribbon with good size, conformation, tight fur but out of condition, although this animal was good enough to take Best Adult Standard Male and Best Adult Standard. The 2nd in the class was also of good size, conformation and clarity, but was also suffering from lack of condition on the day. This animal went on to win Res Best Adult Standard Male.

The Mutation classes both young and adult proved very disappointing, with the young classes producing just three 2nd ribbons with a Beige and a very nice Homo-Beige for Joyce Garvey .

Unfortunately it went downhill from there with the Adult Mutations producing just two 3rd ribbons for a Wilson White and a Black Velvet, both very much out of condition.
